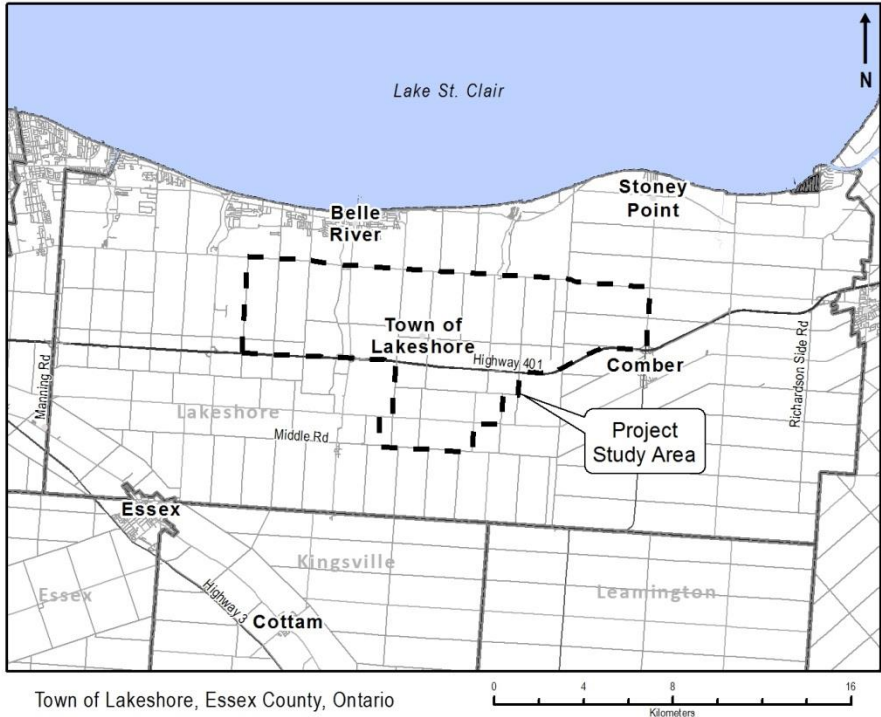


Belle River Wind Project

Community Liaison Committee Meeting #1



The Belle River Wind Project (Project) is a 100 megawatt wind facility located in the Town of Lakeshore, Essex County, Ontario. The Project is being developed by SP Belle River Wind LP, by its general partner, SP Belle River Wind GP Inc. (Belle River Wind), which obtained approval from the Ministry of the Environment and Climate Change (MOECC) to build a Class 4 Wind facility in January 2016.



Formation of a Community Liaison Committee

Belle River Wind has established a Community Liaison Committee (CLC) to discuss the important aspects of construction, installation, use, operation, maintenance and retirement of the Project. The CLC is not intended to revisit matters already addressed through the Renewable Energy Approval process. Belle River Wind views the CLC as a valuable opportunity to include the community in the planning process. As such, CLC meetings will serve as a forum to share ideas and to provide the community with ongoing updates about the Project.
