Community Liaison Committee -- Member Application Form

The Belle River Wind Project is a commercial wind energy generation facility to be located in the Town of Lakeshore, Essex County, Ontario. The project will produce up to 100 megawatts of power and is being developed by SP Belle River Wind LP, by its general partner, SP Belle River Wind GP Inc. (Belle River Wind) which obtained approval from the Ministry of the Environment and Climate Change (MOECC) to build a Class 4 Wind facility in January 2016.

Belle River Wind understands the value of including multiple voices in the discussion regarding the construction, installation, use, operation, maintenance and retirement of the Belle River Wind Project. As a result, Belle River Wind is establishing a Community Liaison Committee (CLC) to act as an advisory body and discuss the important aspects of the project as outlined above. The CLC will serve as a forum to share ideas, express concerns and to provide the community with ongoing updates about the Project.

AECOM has been retained to establish, chair and coordinate CLC meetings for the Belle River Wind Project. As a note, the CLC will not be revisiting items associated with the completed MOECC approval process.

To ensure that the CLC embodies the wide range of community interests, the CLC is intended to consist of up to 14 individuals from the following groups:

- Landowners;
- Residents within 1 km of the Project;
- Aboriginal and First Nations communities;
- Members of the Agriculture community;
- Business / industry representatives;
- Local social and environment organizations; and,
- Representatives from local government agencies.

The CLC is expected to meet at least four times over a two year period, with two meetings each year. The meetings will be held near the Project Location at a time and location that is convenient to most members. We expect to hold our first meeting in late April 2016.

We will consider the following when confirming the CLC membership:

- Knowledge of the community and the issues / concerns / benefits related to wind energy;
- Leadership in / or commitment to the community;
- Ability to effectively address issues and concerns from a variety of perspectives;
- Ability to respectfully participate in community related and consensus-based discussions;
- Interest in working productively to enable two-way communication between Belle River Wind and the community; and,
- Ability to work well in a team or on a committee.

Note: Members of the CLC will be chosen by AECOM. For those who express interest but do not become a part of the CLC, all meetings will be open so that the public can attend and observe the conversation. Requests for delegations will be considered in consultation with the CLC and Belle River Wind. A total of three (3) brief (up to 10 minutes) delegations may be made at each CLC meeting.
